TEEA Alumnae Scholarship Criteria

General Information

- 1. The applicant must be a former 4-H member **or** the son/daughter, grand or great grandchildren of a current TEEA member.
- 2. At the time of application, applicants must have completed a year of higher education and be less than 25 years old. Applicants can apply more than once, even if they are a past recipient.
- **3**. Applications will be available from County Association Chairs, District Directors, and the Chair of the Alumnae Committee. A copy of the application is located on pages A 6-14 and A 6-15, and on the TEEA website. Any TEEA member or Extension agent can make the application available to anyone interested in applying for this scholarship that meets the requirements.
- 4. Completed applications will be sent directly to the State Alumnae Committee Chair and must be postmarked by April 1, with a copy to the TEEA President.
- 5. Applications will be judged at the TEEA Spring Board Meeting.
- 6. Applications will be acknowledged and the winner notified by the Alumnae Chair immediately after judging is completed. The TEEA Scholarship Personal Information Form (page A 12-4) will be sent to the winner. The form is to be completed and returned one copy to the TEEA President and one copy to the TEEA Treasurer to designate the institution to which scholarship funds will be sent.
- 7. The applicant must remain a full-time student, or the amount will be returned to TEEA.
- 8. The scholarship(s) may be applied for use at the beginning of the school semester and used as needed.
