- **George H.W. Bush Presidential Library and Museum** - Explore the life and legacy of President George H.W. Bush through interactive exhibits, historical artifacts, and presidential memorabilia located on the Texas A&M campus. This self-guided museum experience offers a meaningful look into American history and public service.
- **The Gardens at Texas A&M University** - Enjoy a guided tour through beautifully designed gardens, walking trails, and educational landscapes showcasing Texas-friendly plants and horticulture practices. Please note this tour takes place entirely outdoors during the afternoon heat, so comfortable walking shoes, sunscreen, and water are recommended.
- **Kyle Field** - Take a behind-the-scenes tour of one of the most iconic stadiums in college football and experience the traditions and history of Texas A&M athletics. Please note this tour involves a significant amount of walking, stairs, and standing throughout the stadium.
- **American G.I. Museum** - Discover a unique collection of military history exhibits featuring restored military vehicles, artifacts, uniforms, and personal stories from American service members. This museum provides an engaging and educational look at the sacrifices and experiences of the U.S. Armed Forces.
- **Downtown Bryan** - Self-guided tour to Bryan where our past converges with a thriving arts scene, top-rated restaurants, signature events, and eclectic boutiques & antique shops to form the ever-evolving cultural hub of the Brazos Valley. Please wear comfortable walking shoes and bring a water bottle.
- **Messina Hof Winery** - Experience one of Texas' premier wineries with a guided tour highlighting the winemaking process, vineyard history, and the story behind Messina Hof's family-owned operation. Guests will also have the opportunity to enjoy a wine tasting featuring a selection of award-winning Texas wines.
